Scripture Reading Mark 9:2-13

2 After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. 3 His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. 4 And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus. 5 Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah." 6 (He did not know what to say, they were so frightened.) 7 Then a cloud appeared and covered them, and a voice came from the cloud: "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!" 8 Suddenly, when they looked around, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus. 9 As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus gave them orders not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead. 10 They kept the matter to themselves, discussing what "rising from the dead" meant. 11 And they asked him, "Why do the teachers of the law say that Elijah must come first?" 12 Jesus replied, "To be sure, Elijah does come first, and restores all things. He is a leader, a king of 17 villages, a pastor, has brought many to salvation in Jesus Christ and I am blessed to call him my friend. I met Samson years ago and learned of the plight of Nigerians from their abject poverty, especially by American standards, to the frequent attacks on Christians by Boko Haram and the Fulani kidnappers.

Samson's villages face hunger regularly. There are many widows and orphans who struggle greatly. So let's see what we can do to extend our Table of Grace into Nigeria. I found out that \$100 could feed a widow with four children for about a month. \$100 could also purchase large quantities of food that could be distributed across the villages to those most vulnerable. West Bend always rises to the occasion. I'd like to see us raise at least \$500 through August 8 that could bless Samson and his people and spread grace overseas.

Won't you please begin to pray about what you will give and while you are at it, here is a list of prayer points from Samson himself:
