Lt. Clebe McClary is one of the great living heroes of our county. He recounts the courageous story of how he rebuilt his devastated life and he will be here at West Bend Church on Sunday, September 11, 2022. During his tour of duty in Vietnam, he suffered the loss of his left eye, his left arm and subsequently underwent 34 operations to retain usage of the remainder of his body.

Today Clebe McClary is in the service of the Lord's Army. His life shows that he genuinely embodies the vow he took when entering the Marines: Any mission assigned will be accomplished in a superior manner, no matter what the obstacles.

Clebe is what he likes to call a complete Marine. To him, USMC will always mean a U.S. Marine for Christ.

Veterans are so important to us and we would like to honor them when Clebe McClary with us on Sept. 11. Let's support our veterans by bringing some of the needed food supplies that will not only give real food to hungry veterans but also will send the love and encouragement of Jesus Christ right into their lives.
