<u>Matthew Chapter 5</u> 'The Beattitudes' Lessons To Live By

Verse #3 Blessed are those that are poor in spirit for theirs is the Kingdom of God.

Those that are in despair-hopelessness-battling depression, or you just can't find your way or can't find your place, Jesus says these conditions may be overcome with the greatest reward of Salvation, and finding the Will of God.

Verse #4 Blessed are those who mourn, For they shall be comforted.

<u>Philippians 4:7</u> And the Peace of God which passes all understanding shall keep your hearts through Christ Jesus.

Verse #5 Blessed are the meek, For they shall inherit the earth.

What does meek mean? It refers to having strength with control. (with great focus and understanding). Philippians 4: 13 I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.

Verse #6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

Jesus desires that we find the Will of God for our lives.

<u>Matthew 6:33</u> But seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you.

Verse #7 Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy. You must know Christ and God the person- to know about and understand His Mercy.

We must emulate Him and demonstrate mercy as well. <u>Psalms 86: 15</u> But you, O Lord, are a God full of compassion and gracious, longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth. **Verse #8** Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God.

<u>Titus 1:15</u> To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled.

Verse #9 Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called sons of God.

God-like behaviors reflect the life of Jesus (The Prince of Peace.)

<u>Psalm 119: 165</u> Great peace they have which love thy law and nothing shall offend them.

Verses 10, 11, 12 Great Persecutions are coming.
